

## School Annual Education Report (AER) Hamtramck High School

February 10, 2023
Dear Parents and Community Members:
We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Hamtramck High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Principal Dr. Ricardo Martin for assistance.

For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5\% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest $5 \%$ of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below $67 \%$ in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Based on subgroup data a slight gap exists in graduation rates and advanced placement while assessment measurements need improvement in MSTEP science and social studies. It is in these areas Hamtramck High School was identified as a Targeted Support and Intervention (TSI) school. As a TSI our collective efforts have begun in instructional teams to prepare all students for higher learning in Dual Enrollment, Advanced Placement course monitoring. Work needs to be done in the pursuit of career options.

Our population reflects the economic, cultural, ethnic and academic diversity of the city of Hamtramck. The challenge is to ensure that we are providing a rigorous, yet culturally relevant and engaging curriculum in all classrooms while helping students achieve their overall best on SAT Practice, Preliminary SAT, I-Ready, use of Google Classroom to complete all assignments in a timely manner. Students have the
opportunity to sign up for Dual Enrollment and challenge themselves in Advanced Placement courses. Our collective efforts will focus specifically on eliminating practices that fail to yield the desired results with our population of students. A goal is to focus on evidence based instructional practices and systems within our school community that meet the social and emotional needs of our students. This includes restorative practices, Principal's Climate and Culture Zoom meetings for students and face-to-face assemblies. Our teachers will be trained to work collaboratively in Professional Learning Communities (PLCs), High Quality Instruction (HQI) and Instructional Learning Cycles (ILC) to ensure data drives decision making, informs rapid transformation and results in school improvement. Our most important data points are those that allow us to see not only the gaps in achievement but help us to understand the reasons for disparities and continuously improve our collective work to educate the whole student for career and college success.

There are several ways students enter into Hamtramck High School; open enrollment based, based on residency or choice transfer and board of education approval of discipline referrals.
