REFUND POLICY

- Full refund will be given if a program is cancelled by the department. You must collect your funds or use it as a credit within two weeks of being notified.
- Refunds will be issued up until the day before a program starts less a \$5 administration fee, which can be used as a credit to enroll in another program if used the day refund is given.
- Any program less than \$10 will not be issued a refund at any time.
- Refunds for field trips will only be given one (I) week prior to scheduled trip date.
- Refunds will not be issued after the start date of a program
- Refunds are not given if class is cancelled due to weather, school closings, or scheduling conflicts. The department will do its best to offer make-up classes.

RESIDENT RATE

Anyone who lives in Hamtramck, attends, or is employed by the Hamtramck Public Schools district. Proof of residency, employment, or school enrollment is required. Only the person who lives in Hamtramck, or attends/works in the HPS district benefits from the resident rate.
